1. Attendance and Opening

- 20 members attended as per attached attendance register.
- 37 apologies were recorded as per attached register.

2. Confirmation of Previous Minutes

- Minutes from the previous AGM on 2nd September 2023 were circulated to attendees prior to the start of the AGM.
- As part of business arising from the minutes, Brian Hanson requested that the Treasurer's annual report be distributed to members prior to the AGM, so more informed discussions could be had.

3. President's Report

- Andy Males read from his prepared report which focused on the members who make contributions to the successful running of the club.
- Motion: That the report be accepted (Linda Hoskin/ Liz Norton) Carried.

4. Treasurer's Report

- Norm Hoskin presented his report and provided details. His report and that of the auditor are attached.
- Issues raised by members were: future costs for the club's Christmas function, the trajectory
 of the club's operating profit, expense and value of name tags.
- Motion: That the report be accepted (Colleen Skipsey / Bob McCartney) Carried.

5. Bridge Co-Ordinator's Report

- In her acting capacity, Bev Hopley provided a report which was read out by the meeting secretary. The report is attached.
- Motion: That the report be accepted (Liz Norton / Jos de Klerk) Carried.

6. Appointment of outside Auditor

- Lyndon Edwards has been the club's auditor for many years and has provided a great service.
- Clarification was sort about the type of assistance he provides.
- Motion: That Lyndon Edwards continue as the club's auditor (Norm Hoskin / Bob McCartney)
 Carried.

7. Fee Schedule

- Norm Hoskin provided background detail for a fee increase: the committee is establishing a
 five year budget plan to address building repair and refurbishment issues; ABF capitation
 fees are about to rise; recent \$2000 expense for bridge supplies; Christmas function costs.
- The committee will apply for grants whenever practical.
- Motion: The annual membership fees for the BBC be increased to \$70 and associate membership to \$30 (Liz Norton / Gwen Clarke) Carried.

- The new fees are due immediately.
- Table fees are to remain the same.

8. Appointment of an Appeals Panel and a Facilitators Panel

- Current Appeals Panel is Brian Wade and Esther Saunders and the Facilitators Panel is John Ferguson and Mike van Wyk.
- Motion: Composition of the two panels stay the same (Gareth Braid / Linda Hoskin) Carried

9. Election of Management Committee

- The completed Nomination Form is attached.
- There was no nomination for the position of Bridge Co-ordinator. After some discussion about what jobs are entailed, Brian Wade was happy to be nominated. He opened the door for discussions about the role with Marianne Viebke on her return from Sweden.
- One vacancy on the committee remains unfilled. Any member with competence in the computing field is encouraged to come forward.
- All positions were declared filled.

10. New Business

- There was discussion about the Christmas function: members paying something to attend, employing outside caterers, co-ordination. Chris Hollingworth, the committee's liaison person, provided information to the meeting, and indicated Joan Gribble has agreed to coordinate the catering.
- With regard a club session/s where an experienced player is teamed with an inexperienced player, it was suggested these be incorporated into the club's calendar of events for the year.
 This may counteract any lack of support for such events.

11. Other Business

- Andy Males spoke eloquently about Life Members and what they contribute to the club.
- After much consultation with many club members, Andy nominated Judy and Fred Clarke for life membership. This nomination was enthusiastically endorsed by members present. The club thanks them for their magnificent contribution over many years.

12. Club Person of the Year

 Andy Males announced (with much acclaim from the floor) that Mike van Wyk is the 2024 club person of the year.

13. Meeting close

- Brian Wade paid a warm tribute to Andy Males for his contribution as club President for the past seven years and there was strong endorsement from the meeting.
- Norm Hoskin thanked the outgoing committee for their work during the year.
- Meeting closed at 11.43 am.
